2 New Churches in 1 Week

During the last week of April we had the opportunity to work on 2 new church plants. These Churches are part of The PACE Plan.

Juarez, Chiapas

On April 28th, we had originally planned a big evangelistic outreach in the town square in Juarez Chiapas using a Christian Concert with a musician from Chile to draw in new believers. However, because of the swine flu epidemic we were prohibited from holding a mass public meeting. We elected to have the meeting outside the home of one of the believers in Juarez and were fortunate to have a good attendance. That evening we saw new people come to the Lord and we also kicked off the first public meeting of our new Church which will have 5 families attending. On Sunday morning, we held the first meeting where the new pastor, Antonio, ministered. I'll be helping him with \$100 monthly as part of our PACE plan for establishing new churches.

Tzomjok, Cancuc, Chiapas

On April 30, I traveled deep into the mountains near Cancuc, Chiapas to help with a brand new church plant in a place called Tzomjok. There was previously no evangelical church in this tribal community.

Our original goal for church planting was 12 new churches in a year's time. God is bigger than that. In addition to Juarez and Tzomjok we have been fortunate to be a part of 2 more church plants for a total of 4 new churches this month.

Betania

Betania is a community where the Christian Indian refugees fled when they were persecuted by the Zapatistas years ago.

God just opened the doors for us to be a part of a new church in this predominantly Christian area. In addition, the Pastor, who is full of vision, will be planting 3 more churches in remote areas in the coming days... Stay tune for more exciting news!

Recent PACE Projects - How We're Spending Your Donations

The PACE Plan (Plant A Church Effort) Involves 3 Stages:

1. Evangelistic Outreach and initial meeting with a new Pastor
2. Renting or constructing a temporary place for new believers to meet in (acquiring land)
3. Transition of the work into an Indigenous Church by obtaining a church building and self supported Pastor.

We have completed some recent projects and have a list of upcoming projects located at www.thepaceplan.com for you to view. Here's how we've spent money you are donating to this ministry:

- **Bochil** - Various Projects for Expanding the Church facilities including 2 ministry teams
- **Tzajalachen** - \$2000 for Roof
- **Tzenembolon** - \$1,950 for a new church building
- **Chenahlo** - \$600 for Dormitories
- **Acteal** - \$400 for tin roofs
- **Cancuc Pozo** - \$300 for cement wall
- **Yibijoj** - \$200 for very sick Pastor's medical expenses
- **Tuxtla Gutierrez** - \$1000 towards the \$200,000 needed for Unanimous Ministries building facilities
- **Tzonjok** - \$1,200 for a new church plant and building
- **Betania** - \$50 for part of tin roof
- **Chiquinxulum** - \$350 for chairs/pews
- **Chenahlo** - 2 Cows + \$500 for Pastors housing and the main church covering for the Indians
- **Juarez** - \$100 monthly for one year starting in May to help new Pastor in this new Church
